Subject: 2010 Rules Addendum

The following is issued as an addendum to the Illinois Swimming Rules and Regulations, updated and published in October 2008. The following amendments were adopted in October, 2010 and become effective on November 10, 2010. Please place a copy of these amendment(s) into your current ISI rulebook.

# Illinois Swimming Rules & Regulations

## Amendments 2010

Adopted by the House of Delegates on 10/10/2010 and effective 11/10/2010

### PART ONE

#### Interpretations and Authorities

##### 101 Interpretive Authority of ISI Rules

- .1 The ISI House of Delegates has sole authority to officially interpret ISI Rules and applicable definitions except as further specified in Part One.
- .2 The ISI Board of Directors may issue interim interpretations of ISI Rules subject to approval by the ISI House of Delegates at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the House of Delegates.

##### 102 Interim Interpretations of ISI Rules

- .1 Interim interpretations shall be distributed to all ISI clubs and be available on the ISI website at least 30 days prior to effective date.
- .2 Interim interpretations of ISI Championship meet rules or procedures shall be included in the official Championship Meet announcement.
- .3 Interim interpretations of ISI Championship Meet rules or procedures shall be made at least 90 days prior to the first date of competition.
- .4 Interim interpretations of ISI Championship Meet rules or procedures are not permitted within 90 days of the first date of competition.

##### 203.4 ENTRIES

- .8 All host clubs in all competitions that add athletes after the entry deadline or as a deck entry must receive proof of current registration from the club requesting the addition. Failure to do so will result in a \$50.00 (fifty dollar) fine to the host club and a \$50.00 (fifty dollar) fine to the club who submitted the entry. Fines will be based on the final results received from the host club.

206.5 ADMINISTRATIVE CONDUCT FOR ISI LSC CHAMPIONSHIPS

.7 Meet Host Responsibility for Providing Timers - The Meet Host shall have full responsibility for timers for all sessions of the Meet. Meet hosts may request timers from other clubs, but they may not be required of any club.

206.5 ADMINISTRATIVE CONDUCT FOR ISI LSC CHAMPIONSHIPS

.9 Scratch Procedure for LSC Championship Meets - The USA Swimming Nationals Championship scratch rule (Article 207.12.6) shall be in effect for all ISI Age Group and Senior Championship Meets.

206.5 ADMINISTRATIVE CONDUCT FOR ISI LSC CHAMPIONSHIPS

0.14 MEETS HELD OUTSIDE THE ILLINOIS LSC

- A. For any championship meet held outside the Illinois LSC, the meet host will be financially responsible to pay Illinois Swimming all Illinois LSC required fees consistent with Illinois sanctioning rules and regulations as if the meet were hosted in an Illinois venue. (Effective as of 9-1-2011)
- B. For any championship meet held outside the Illinois LSC, the athlete event fees will not be increased beyond the host LSC defined fees, however, the meet host may charge an additional facility fee not to exceed the additional cost charged to the host team by the Illinois LSC.

## 208.1 PENALTIES

- .1 Any club violating any provisions of the sanction or approval is the rules and regulations of Illinois Swimming or the USA Swimming Code shall be may be subject to any or all of the following penalties of:
- A Forfeiture of the sanction or approval fee.
- (1) ~~Assessment of \$100.00 per half hour for each half hour or any portion thereof that the meet exceeds the daily time limit.~~
- ~~(2)~~ B One year probation and increased sanction fee for any meet hosted during this one year probationary period. A portion of the increased sanction fee not to exceed fifty percent (50%) shall be returned to the meet host if all obligations are met (in time and form) and if all rules and regulations which govern the meet have been followed.
- C Suspension from hosting any sanctioned ISI Meets (other than conference dual meets, etc.) for a period of one year.
- .2 Any club violating any of the provisions of ISI Article 203.3.1 or .2 (Time Schedule) may be subject to the penalties listed in 208.1.1 and assessment of \$150.00 per hour for each hour or any portion thereof that the meet exceeds the daily time limit.
- ~~.2~~ .3 Any club, while on probation, violating any of the provisions of the sanction or the rules and regulations of ISI or the USA Swimming Code shall be subject to any or all ~~of the following penalties:~~ penalties listed in this article.
- A — ~~Forfeiture of Sanction Fee~~
- (1) ~~Assessment of \$100.00 fine per half hour for each half hour or any portion thereof that the meet exceeds the daily time limit.~~
- (2) ~~Suspension from hosting any sanctioned ISI Meets (other than conference dual meets, etc.) for a period of one year.~~
- ~~.3~~ .4 No action shall be taken... *no further changes*

602.1 MEMBERS – The membership of ISI shall consist of the following:

.2 INDIVIDUAL MEMBERS

.E OUTREACH MEMBER – is an Athlete Member who qualifies for a discounted membership per the ISI Procedures and Policies Manual. An Athlete Member may qualify for an Outreach Membership by meeting one of two criteria:

1. Be eligible for free or reduced school lunch. Proof of eligibility must be submitted with the Outreach Membership Application.

2. Be receiving assistance from a recognized scholarship/grant program through their CLUB MEMBER organization. Proof of assistance must be submitted with the Outreach Membership Application.
