

Lake Forest Club Aquatic Program Director and Swim Coach

Located in scenic Lake Forest, Illinois close to the shores of Lake Michigan, LFC stays true to its founding mission of offering its members great recreational activities.

Job Description

Under the guidance of the General Manager, the Aquatics Director is responsible for managing the daily operations of our swimming facilities at LFC from late May to early September. The Club's facilities include 3 pools - lap pool, diving pool, and baby pool. This seasonal position works independently and is expected to be able to fulfill the following key responsibilities.

Responsibilities as aquatics director include the following:

- Manage a safe, **fun** and effective daily swim program for the members including swim team, camp, and other general pool usage.
- Hires, trains and supervises staff and volunteers for all aquatic programs.
- Ensures all activities comply with state and safety standards.
- Assist in the daily maintenance of pool and physical operation of the pools. Monitors and purchases necessary aquatic equipment.
- Supervise / maintain bath house facilities

Responsibilities of the swim coach include the following:

- Responsible to lead and develop swimming team of over 100 children
- Lead swim practices to promote stroke development and physical conditioning
- Coordinate swim meets including staffing, officiating, lineups, pool readiness, etc

Requirements

- Applicants must be enthusiastic with good communication skills, great energy and a positive attitude.
- All applicants must have current (or be willing to obtain) the following certifications: Water Safety Instructor (WSI), Lifeguard, First Aid and CPR certifications.
- Experience with program management and swim instruction required.
- Bachelor's degree in related field or equivalent preferred.
- Five years related experience preferred.
- USA Swimming Coach Certification preferred.
- Demonstrated experience in service industry a plus
